Open to artists 18 years of age and older, this exhibition traditionally brings together a diverse group of artists working in a variety of media.

During this period, the Art Center has remained dedicated to its mission of bringing the excitement of the visual arts to the region through education, exhibition, permanent collections and the support of artists.

## ELIGIBILITY

The Wanda J. Skogerboe juried exhibition is open to artists 18 years of age or older. All works must be original, completed in the last two years and not previously exhibited at the Pearson Lakes Art Center.

## JURY FEE

\$15.00 fee covers up to three entries. Used exclusively for exhibition organization. Non-refundable.

## AWARDS

Top prize in the show will be awarded a solo exhibition during the 2019 Visual Arts Season of the Pearson Lakes Art Center. Honorable Mentions will also be awarded, at the discretion of the judge.

## JUDGE

Joanne Alberda, Professor of Art (retired), Dordt College. A studio artist as well as a designer and consultant for liturgical textiles, Alberda taught art at Dordt College for 40 years. Her work has been featured in solo exhibitions in Iowa, Minnesota and Michigan and in juried shows such as the Quilt Surface Design Symposium and the Annual National Clay, Fiber, Paper, Glass, Metal, Wood Show.

## SPECIFICATIONS

Each artist may submit a maximum of three works. Submission of works in all media is greatly encouraged. Three-dimensional works may not exceed 150 pounds in weight and dimensions may not exceed 60 inches (5 feet) in any one direction. Two-dimensional work may not exceed 40 pounds in weight and 60 inches (5 feet) in any one direction.

## FRAMING

All wall-hung work must be framed and/or equipped with ready-to-hang wire or loop hanging devices. The Pearson Lakes Art Center reserves the right to reject previously accepted work due to inadequate framing/mounting or for security or public safety reasons. All works must be maintenance free.

## PUBLICITY

The Pearson Lakes Art Center reserves the right to photograph all exhibited works and to use these photographs for catalog, educational, and/or publicity purposes.

## SALES, INSURANCE and LIABILITY

Sales to the public are encouraged. The Pearson Lakes Art Center will retain 40% commission. Prices listed on the entry form must reflect this commission. If the work is not for sale, list NFS and state insurance value. Prices of accepted works may not be changed. The Pearson Lakes Art Center will provide insurance on all works while at the Art Center. The Art Center will not assume liability for loss or damage during transit to or from the Art Center; artists are encouraged to purchase their own in transit insurance.

## DELIVERY

All accepted works can either be sent or hand-delivered to the Pearson Lakes Art Center no later than 4:00 p.m. Saturday, November 11th. Works must be identified with artist name and title. All exhibited work must be picked up during regular business hours after January 27th, 2018. Entries must be picked up by Saturday, February 17th; work remaining after this date will become property of the Art Center, unless special arrangements are made with the Visual Arts Director. Shipping costs will be the artist's responsibility.
